BASICS ABOUT BIRDS

Topic:

Birds

Activity:

This lesson covers an informative discussion on the general characteristics of a bird – feathers, beak, lays eggs, etc. Each learner will be given a set of binoculars and a bird identification sheet. They will be taken out to one of the bird hides on the Island to identify some of the birds that are found on the Island, as well as have a closer look at the different nests.



PLANT PARADISE

Topic:

Plants, seeds and where they come from and what plants need in order to grow

Activity:

Learners will be taken to an outdoor classroom where they will identify some of the plants that are found on Intaka Island. They will then collect some samples of plants to help them identify the different parts of a plant. In groups they will also discuss the importance of plants and what plants need in order to grow.



WATER PURIFICATION

Topic:

Water - Recycling
Healthy environment - The importance of a clean environment, ways in which people pollute it and the importance of recycling

Activity:

Learners will be taken to the Sustainability Classroom to learn how Intaka keeps its environment healthy. They will get to build their own sand filters with materials found on the Island and put them to the test.
