EDUCATIONAL USES	Educating visitors and school kids on “renewable energy” generated from solar, and will explain the Eco Centre’s electricity usage vs solar energy generated via the Solar installation. Promoting an “off-the-grid” option to households and businesses, as part of the Century City Smart City <i>Environmental Sustainability Program</i> .

SPECIFICATIONS	Hik vision Outdoor 2-MP 25X Ultra-low Light Network Darkfighter PTZ Dome Camera
EDUCATIONAL USES	Intaka had 4 outdated web-/dome cameras on the Island that were barely operational. Securitas and Bona Electronic Solutions have recently each donated an upgraded camera. The remaining 2 urgently require replacement. The cams provide live footage of birder sites around the Island and visitors can access the footage as live feedback on Intaka’s webpage. This gives the viewer a real-time experience of what is happening on the Island. It is used by general visitors and school teachers to better understand the Intaka offering and by birders to check what bird species are at the heronries, birdhides, etc to plan their visits. The cameras can also be viewed in the Eco-Centre entrance foyer.
