FRONT PAWS

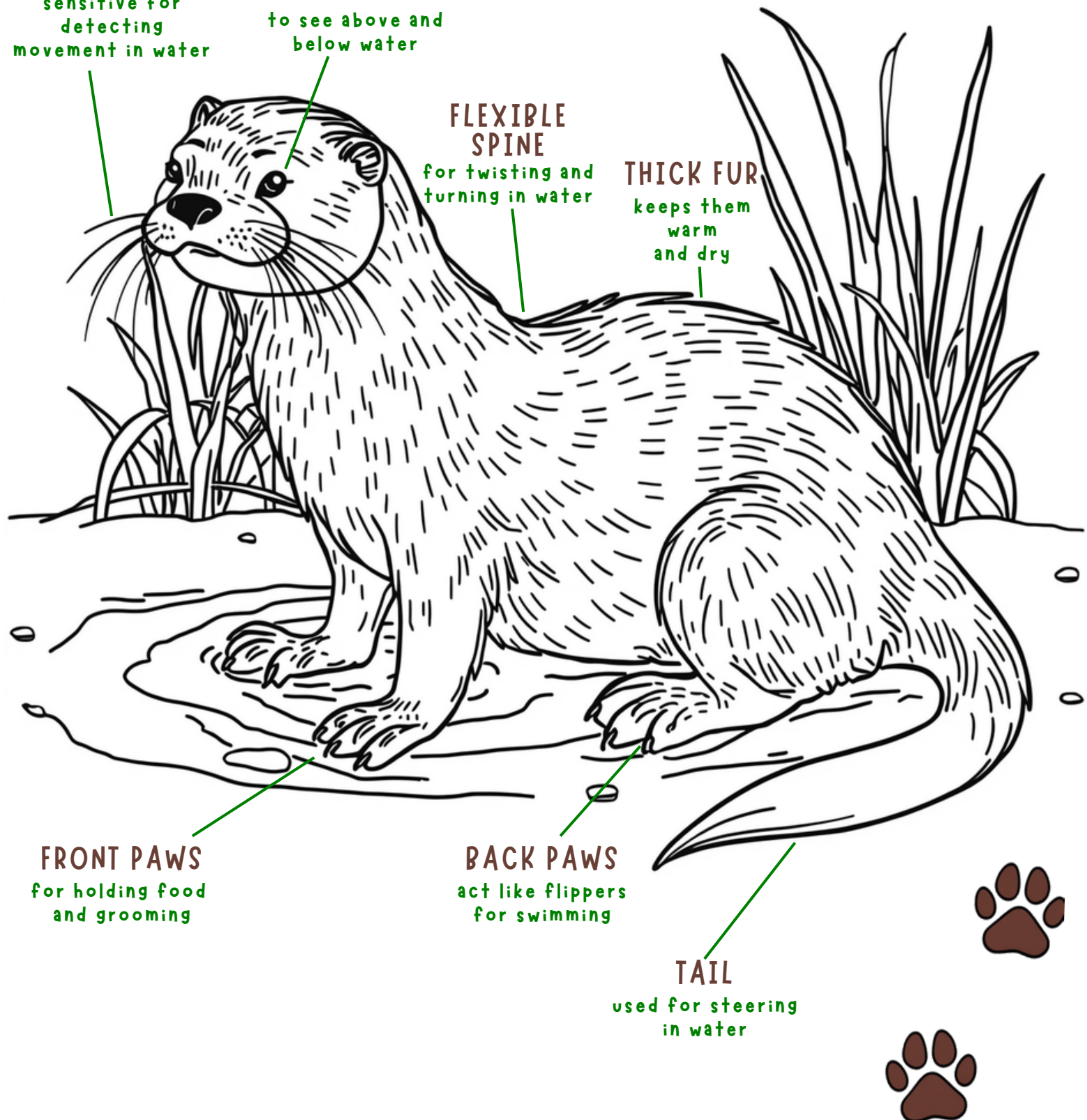
for holding food

LET'S GET OTTERLY CREATIVE!

Get creative with this paper bag otter craft and make your very own otter friend right at home.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

A brown paper bag | Cardboard | Newspaper | Scissors
Black marker | Glue stick | A rubber band

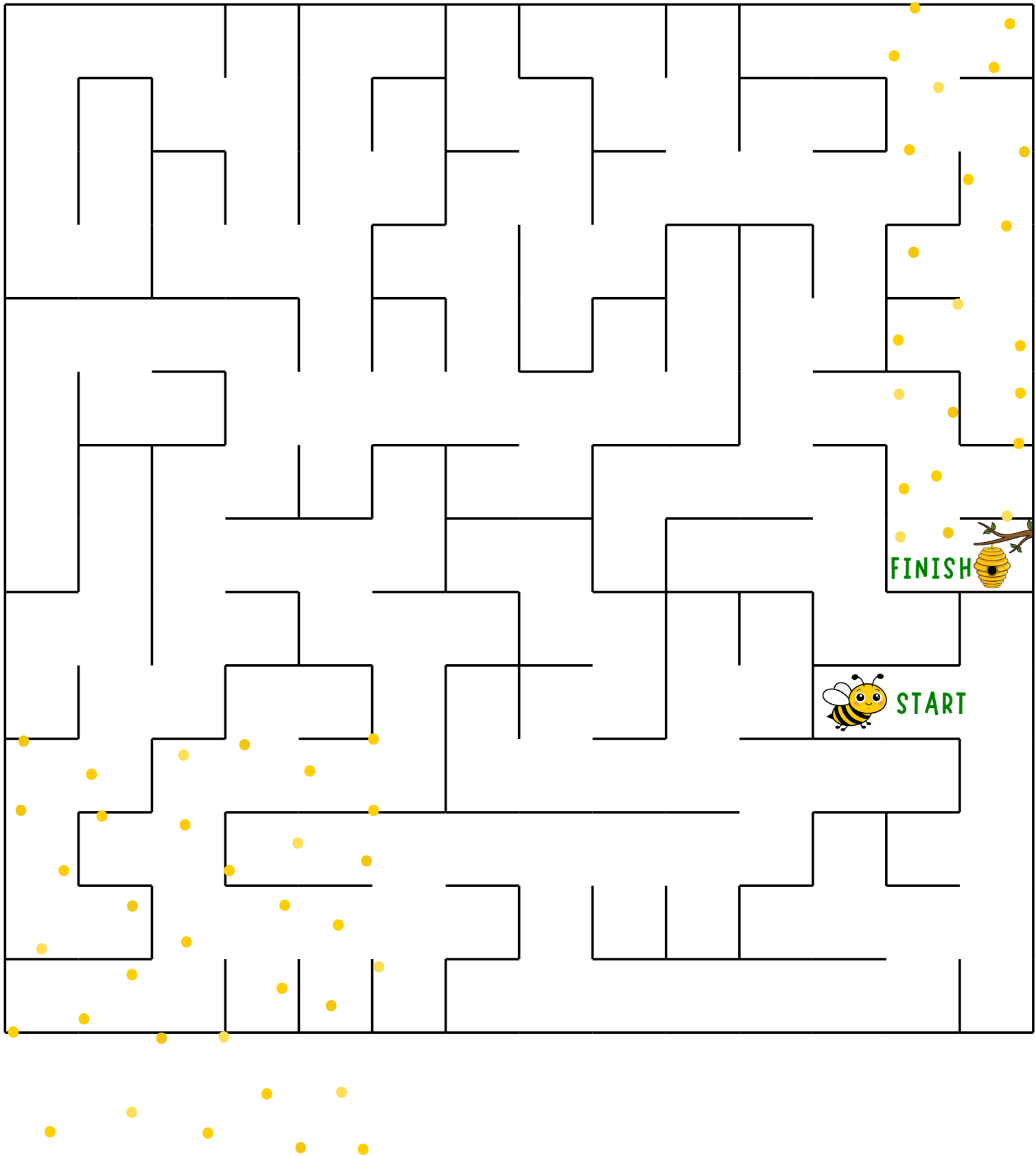
HOW TO DO IT:

- Using cardboard and scissors, cut out one head and four paw shapes.
- Use a marker to draw the otter's face and paw details on the cardboard.
- Glue the otter head on the closed end of the brown paper bag. Attach the two front paws to the sides of the bag, close to the head.
- Crumple newspaper into balls and stuff them inside the paper bag until the body looks round and full.
- Gather the open end of the paper bag and tie it with a rubber band.
- Attach the two back paws on either side of the elastic band so they look like the otter's back feet and tail.

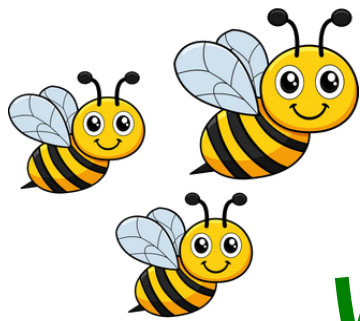
